DRESS CODE

1. Crew neck shirts or t-shirts, preferably a STK shirt
2. No shirts with any symbols on them
3. No V-cut shirts
4. No leggings or tight fitted pants
5. Loose fitting pants only with no rips
6. No shorts
7. No jewelry: ear rings, watches, bracelets, necklaces, etc. are allowed
8. Nothing in pockets: wallets, phones, money, pens, keys, etc. are allowed
9. No open toed shoes, high-heels, or boots, preferably sneakers
10. No chewing gum
11. No hoodies
12. No hats or caps
13. No ties
14. No candy

****This is a strict dress code and for those who do not follow the code will be sent home before entering the facility. For those who have a disability (caste, brace, etc.) only some codes will apply.**

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. All volunteers must be sober while participating in STK activities
2. No tolerance for drugs, weapons, alcohol, or any other illegal substances or promotion of them
3. No tolerance for fighting, including bad language, insults, or discriminating terms
4. No tolerance for gang symbols or items
5. A commitment to nonviolence and against oppression and discrimination of any kind, a respect for all, no interrupting/cutting off people, and a commitment to being compassionate and helpful
6. A commitment to keeping every place a safe space, no sexual conduct, hitting on, hooking up, or sexual engagement of any kind
7. A commitment to representing STK professionally and legally in the community
8. No personal communication with residents, no taking anything in or out of the detention facility for residents or staff
9. No personal relationship building on a one-to-one basis with residences or staff
10. No contacting residences' family, friends, or tell others that they are there at all or use their names in anyway (e.g., e-mail, text message, phone, or in person) outside of detention facility.
11. To hold to privacy in all meetings at detention facilities and at all volunteer/staff meetings, but if violent, harmful, discriminating, or other illegal conduct is taking place it must be brought to detention staff.
12. To give one week (7 days) notice for canceling on any obligation, if not respected more than twice the person will be asked to not come back.
13. To only miss maximum of once a month, if not respected more than twice the person will be asked to not come back.

GROUND-RULES

1. One person speaks at a time
2. No interrupting anyone
3. Be respectful to everyone
4. No put downs of yourself or others even in a joking way
5. All residence can leave at anytime
6. Want to participate
7. Volunteer yourself only
8. To KISS – Keep It Short and Sweet, allow others to speak, and no interrupting/cutting off others
9. To respect the “buzzword” for the purpose of bring the group together to focus on a particular issue be it at a workshop/training or extracurricular activity and only volunteer yourself and not others
