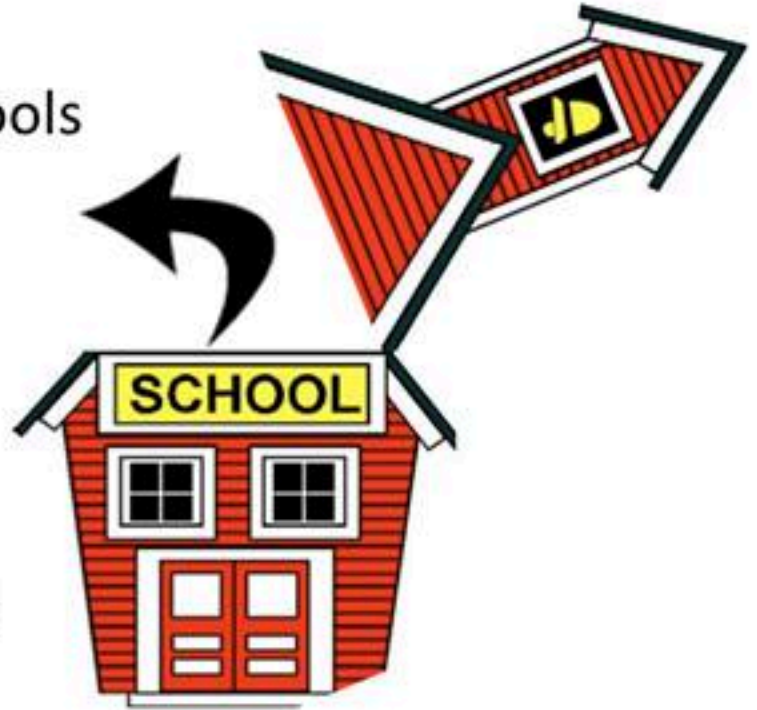




Erosion of Public Schools

1. Students are taken out of public schools and put into charter schools, because public schools are not addressing the needs and cultures of students.



2. Charter schools then take funding away from public schools.



3. With budgets cut, public schools decrease student resources and staff and increase class sizes.



4. Desperate for funding, public schools contract with corporations to standardize practices, rules, policies, and education (e.g. Common Core).
